Our 3rd Annual cruise aboard the Minneapolis Queen paddle boat is on Thursday, Sept. 26, 2013. Boarding will begin at 5:30 p.m., with Departure time at 6:00pm sharp. Remember that there is rush hour traffic at that time. The 2 hour cruise includes light narration of points of interest of Upper Mississippi River Gorge National Park with great views and passage through Lower Lock (25ft) to view St. Anthony Falls.

To have the private Admiral's Cabin on the Upper Deck reserved for our group we must have a head count of at least 32 people, so you are encouraged to bring your relatives and friends. Open seating is available on the lower deck as well. Rest rooms and air conditioning provided.

Price: Adults - \$24, Children - \$16. (Discounted price.) . It is encouraged to pay this by the September EMYC Meeting to Larry Wheeler so an approximte head count can be planned. Otherwise payment is due before boarding. New location Is on the map shown below, which is at Bohemian Flats (West Bank U of M). This is a PAY Box in the parking lot, located in front of the boats., and put the receipt on the dash of your car. The pay box accepts credit cards or cash. The charge is \$1 per hour.
