My newest project is a model of a Swedish ferry similar to the ones taken by Brigetta as a young girl growing

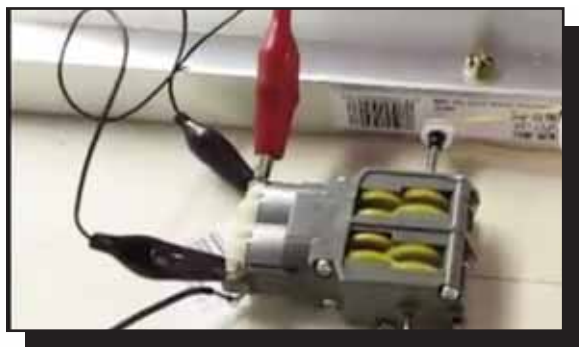
up in the Stockholm archipelago. It was to have been a winter project but it already has a good start. Four foot in length and all wood with and plank on frame.

First conveyor geared motor test - Here is an angle shot showing the conveyors. The gap underneath the conveyors leaves enough room for 8 volt, 12 amp batteries. The overall system will run at 12 volts, so the battery setup may change.
